In collaboration with the Child Guidance Clinic at IMH, RMHC Singapore mailed out cheerful post cards periodically to children in need to provide emotional support and encourage resilience post discharge and in-between their outpatient visits.



In the third quarter of 2019, we collaborated with our hospitality partners to support families with sick children under the care of NUH Paediatric Home Care Programme through a staycation programme as a form of respite for them.



In 2019, we had 112 active volunteers: 90 at NUH, 10 at IMH and 12 for the Happy Wheel Cart Programme. Out of 93 newly oriented volunteers, 73 remained active following training.
