We are excited to share that the new Ronald McDonald Family Room in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) Ward at National University Hospital just opened this month.

Located within the NICU, the lounge will be able to accommodate up to 8 persons where they will be able to rest and have their meals. Fitted with 2 lactation rooms, mothers will also be able to pump and deliver breastmilk to their child with more comfort and convenience.

We would like to thank the National University Hospital for partnering us and sharing our vision to enhance the quality of support and care for seriously ill children and their families in Singapore.

No Help Too Small



At just 5 weeks old, Baby Zayn, has been in the news here in Singapore for the hefty medical bills from a prescription gene therapy that he needs for his medical condition. He was diagnosed with Spinal Muscular Atrophy (SMA) Type 1 – a genetic neuromuscular disease that causes muscles to become weak and requires Zolgensma (a single dosage costs close to SGD 3 Million) and Risdiplam (a daily dosage drug which lasts 64 days, amounting to SGD 15,167.50 per bottle)

His parents, Nabeel and Syahirah, have been staying with us at the Ronald McDonald House through this ordeal. We humbly ask that you support the family to give Zayn a chance of survival and a better quality of life growing up.
